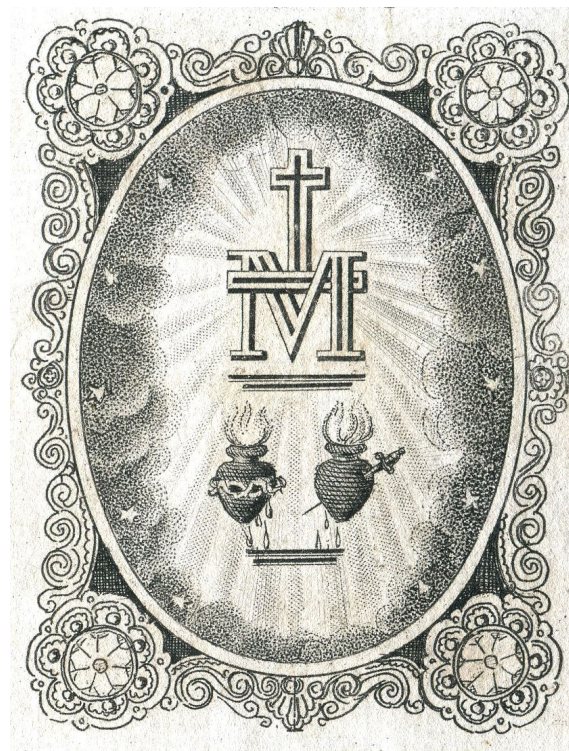

On December 26th, 1957 Father Augustin Fuentes interviewed Sister Lucia, one of the visionaries of Fatima.

Among many other important pieces of information, Sister Lucia revealed:

"Father, the most Holy Virgin is very sad because no one has paid any attention to Her Message, neither the good nor the bad. The good continue on their way, but without giving any importance to Her Message. The bad, not seeing the punishment of God actually falling upon them, continue their life of sin without even caring about the Message. But believe me, Father, God will chastise the world and this will be in a terrible manner. The punishment from Heaven is imminent."

We are Catholics that are committed to hearing Our Lady's message and sharing the burden of additional prayer and suffering for the conversion of friends, loved ones, and all that are away from the True Faith

The Intent is for each of us to take at least one day per week as a day of intense fasting, prayer, and sacrifice (with the Desert Fathers as an example) for the intentions of this group that we may, as a community, merit the conversion of many to God.

In taking up this voluntary Devotion we seek to unite prayers and mortifications in Reparation for sins, for the conversion of Souls on Earth, and release of those in Purgatory, and to increase our own Holiness. Throughout each week select one day (Recommended not Sunday as we should not Fast on the day Our Lord arose from the dead) and substitute the prayers for that specific day for the "Penance Day" prayers at the end of this booklet.

The Breastplate of St. Patrick,
also known as The Lorica

The Lorica is an ancient Gaelic prayer attributed to St. Patrick and is an invocation to the Holy Trinity, usually recited in the morning. In the early Irish Church, loricas were numerous; some were written in Gaelic and some in Latin. In fact, the word, Lorica, is Latin, meaning shield or breastplate. Since prayer is a spiritual shield, these Irish loricas were prayed for protection against spiritual evils, but also from physical ones; the loricas came into being when the Gaelic pagans converted to Catholicism: the loricas were the replacement for the old incantations, which the new Christians discarded.
